
#### MEMBERSHIP SESSIONS:

- Okay...we need some help. We've got bullet holes appearing in the square metal poles which hold up the metal safety frames on the range. This is really stupid. The bullets are supposed to land inside the large dirt berms. The metal frames are strictly safety devices. They are not to be shot at indiscriminately. We did a major rebuilding of a lot of the frames a couple of years ago. We can do without the bullet holes in the metal structures or we can do without the idiots who don't know how to shoot their firearms. If you don't know how to follow your copy of the safety rules then simply ask. Or...you can turn in

your key and go away.

- We are planning repair and improvements at the range over this year. The most pressing issue is the erosion damage around the backstop. Some of the support pylons have shifted. Getting them fixed is likely to require heavy equipment and cost a pretty penny. We're looking at several options.
- We still need to hack away at the retama and mesquite behind the 100 yard bay and east of the 200 yard. It needs to be cleared to prevent it from growing and being a big problem. It is better done in the cool climate than the blast furnace of summer. Details might shut down the 100 and/or 200 yard bays while clearing operations occur. Stay tuned to the website for updates on this.
